

## Assembly Instructions


Required Tools: Screwdriver, hammer | Recommended Tool: Power drill with Philips bit Included: 1 small board with attached lace (shelf), 1 large board (back), 2 semi-circles (sides), 6 large dowels, 5 small dowels, 4 knobs with screws, 2 long screws, 4 short screws




<u>Step 1:</u> Install five small dowels in shelf by carefully tapping with hammer. Check that all are secure and straight.




<u>Step 2:</u> Use two long screws to attach shelf to back. Install screws evenly. Check that connection is secure. *Note: If gap exists between boards, back screws out and retry.* 



Step 3: Match flat end of side with mark to end of back that also has mark. Use two short screws to attach each side to back. Place side on flat surface so that you can push down on screws. Install screws evenly. Check that connections are secure. Note: Flat end of side should be flush with wall side of back.



<u>Step 4:</u> Install three large dowels in each side by aligning with hole and carefully tapping with hammer. Check that all are secure and straight.



<u>Step 5:</u> Install knobs in four holes across the bottom of back. *Note: Avoid putting pressure on lace while installing screws.* 

<u>Step 6:</u> Mount unit on wall using sawtooth hangers attached to back. Use large nails or screws to support weight.

## For your safety, please:

- ensure that unit is securely mounted on wall to prevent it from falling.
  - supervise small children who may try to pull unit off of wall.
